

Thank-you to all parents and guardians for their support and encouragement throughout the year! We couldn't do it without you!



If your child needs RVS transportation to Northcott Prairie next year, please be aware of transportation registration deadlines:

Register Now for 2024/25 Bus Transportation

Time is running out to receive a discount on your transportation registration!
Families who register before June 30 will receive an early registration discount of \$40. This is extended to each of the first two students in a family, with additional students receiving \$20 off if registering early. A minimum payment of 50 per cent is due at registration. Bus service may be cancelled up until Oct.
31, 2024 to receive a full refund. A step-by-step guide to registration is available on Transportation Registration & Fee Payment.

To guarantee service for the first day of school, registration must be received before Aug. 1. Students registered after this deadline may experience delays of two to three weeks before they can ride the bus as late applications will be processed with a start date after Sept. 18.
