October Update From Administration

Thank-you for taking the time to come out to our fall parent-teacher interviews. As assessments are populated into the [Power School parent portal](#), it is vital that you check on your child's academic progress through our Real-Time Reporting process. Don't forget to click on the indicator button (EMG, PRG,ADV, etc.) and the blue graph icon to show the Alberta Education Standards/Outcomes that are reflected in the assignment to get the full picture. You have to click around quite a bit to see more details, such as the "view" button to see assignment descriptions or personal comments.

If you have questions, please contact the office or your child's teacher. Please see the graphic below to gain clarity on what you see in Power School.

Green – within grade level

Blue – below grade level

Grade	Descriptor	Description
MAS	Mastering	Evidence indicates in-depth understanding, demonstration, and/or application of the outcome.
ADV	Advancing	Evidence indicates comprehensive understanding, demonstration, and/or application of the outcome.
PRG	Progressing	Evidence indicates required understanding, demonstration, and/or application of the outcome.
EMG	Emerging	Evidence indicates development toward understanding, demonstration, and/or application of the outcome.
BEG	Beginning	Evidence indicates initial understanding, demonstration and/or application of the outcome.
LIM	Limited	Evidence indicates limited or incomplete level of understanding, demonstration and/or application of the outcome.
IE	Insufficient Evidence	Insufficient evidence submitted to accurately assess the outcome.
